Consultations in Your Local Area ~ Minsei-iin and Jido-iin ~


Did you know that in your local community there are people called "Minsei-iin" and "Jido-iin"?



 - 4) After checking the response letter, a Personal Seal Registration Certificate will be given.

Important!

You cannot register the following personal seals:

- 1) A personal seal without your last name, given name, or a part of your last name or given name.
- 2) A personal seal with your occupation, qualifications, or other items listed together
- 3) A personal seal made of rubber or any other personal seals that are subject to changes in shape
- 4) A seal whose impression fits within the 8mmX8mm square or does not fit within the 25mmX25mm square
- 5) A blurry impression of the personal seal or an impression with letters that are difficult to read.
- 6) Besides personal seals listed above, personal seals determined by the mayor as unfit for registration.

Cancellation of Personal Seal Registration

If you lose your Koka Shimin Card or the registered personal seal, you can cancel your registration.

Changing Your Registered Personal Seal

Please submit a Cancellation of Personal Seal Application for the old seal as well as a Personal Seal Registration Application for the new one at the same time.

Damage or Loss of Koka Shimin Card

If your card is lost or severely damaged, you can exchange it for a new one. Please submit a Cancellation of Personal Seal Application and a Personal Seal Registration Application at the same time.

Address Displays / 住居表示 / Jukyo Hyoji

*Only for residential areas

*For areas that end in 「〇番〇号」(___ ban ___ go)

In the following cases, please follow the procedures for changing an address. If you do not follow the procedures, postal items may not arrive which may interfere with your daily life. There are some cases where no change is necessary, so please inquire if you are unsure.

- 1) When building a new house or apartment
- 2) When renovating an existing house or apartment
- 3) When the building has not changed, but the access point to a public road has changed.

Change of Address Displays Certificate/住所表示変更証明書/Jusho Hyoji Henka Shomeisho

In the case of a separation or merger of districts, the city will issue of Change of Address Displays Certificate free of charge. For those who need this Certificate, please request one when filing a Change of Address Displays Application at city hall's Shimin Ka or at any of the following Chiiki Shimin Centers; Tsuchiyama, Koka-Ohara, Konan Daiichi, or Shigaraki.
