System Changes from August

Until now, people between the ages of 70 and 74 needed a Standard Medical Reduction Application only if they were in households exempted from residence tax. However, starting in August, those who make the same amount of money as standard workers (and pay 30% copay at medical facilities) will also have to get a Medical Expense Limit Application (Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho) if they are Level 2 earners (taxable income of 3,800,000 yen or more per year) or Level 1 earners (taxable income of 1,450,000 yen or more per year). For more information, please check the pamphlet that came in the same envelope as your Elderly Benefits Certificate (Korei Jukyusha Sho).

In Koka City, subsides are given to people with disabilities and single-parent families to help relieve economic burdens of medical expenses. If you are receiving this subsidy, a status update form will be sent to you.






