Family Support Center for Childcare

Through the Family Support Center, those who need help with childcare (Onegai Kai-in) can receive support from other members (Makasete Kai-in) for a small fee.

For example:

-When you need someone to pick up/drop off your child at nursery school/kindergarten

Flu Shots for the Elderly (65 years old +)

Unlike the common cold, the influenza virus can cause not only a cough and runny nose, but also high fevers. In the elderly, the flu can lead to pneumonia and possibly death.

Therefore, to prevent the spread of disease and to protect yourself, please be sure to get your flu vaccine.

Target: Those who fall under either \bigcirc or \bigcirc .

- ① People who are 65 years old or older
- ② People who are 60 to 64 years old with: a heart condition, a respiratory (lung) condition), a kidney condition, an auto-immune disease or a physical disability grade level 1.

Vaccination Period: Now until the end of December (details depend on the medical facility)

Things to Bring: Your health insurance card or latestage elderly insurance card

Fee: 2,000 yen (pay at the medical facility)

Fee Exemption: Those who fall under the following do not have to pay the fee:

- -Those on public assistance or welfare
- -Those who are exempt from Residence Tax for the 2018 fiscal year (Heisei 30)

If you qualify, please apply before immunization.

How to Apply for Exemption: We will send out and receive applications by the process listed below. Please make sure to fill out and submit the application during the application period (no applications will be accepted after receiving the flu shot).

**For those between 60 and 64 years old, please bring your disability handbook (techo) or a copy.

Application Method: Please receive an application from Sukoyaka Shien Ka at City Hall or at any Hoken Center or Chiiki Shimin Center. The application can also be downloaded from the Koka City homepage or mailed directly to you, so please call for more information. Once you have filled out the application, please send it back to Sukoyaka Shien Ka (we ask that you pay the postage).

- If you wish to get vaccinated at a medical facility outside of Koka City, you must consult with Sukoyaka Shien Ka at least 2 weeks before the vaccination.
- You can also receive the elderly pneumococcal vaccine at the same time. Those who qualify for the 2018 fiscal year (Heisei 30) should receive the vaccination to prevent pneumonia. For more information, please refer to the Health Checkup Calendar.

How to Report Injuries Caused by Another Person

If you are injured by someone else and are covered by National Health Insurance (or the Late-Stage Elderly Insurance), the insurance will cover hospital fees. Later, the person who caused the injury will be billed.

Therefore, if you are injured, please contact Hoken Nenkin Ka as soon as you have filed a police report.

Examples of Incidents That Are Covered by Insurance

- 1. Traffic accident (including bicycles)
- 2. Injury due to violence
- **3.** Bitten by another person's pet, etc.

*Before settling the dispute (taking money, etc.) with the other person, you MUST call Hoken Nenkin Ka.

Have You Applied for the My Number Card?

You can use the My Number Card as personal identification, receive certificates such as the Residence Certificate at convenience stores, and do your taxes online with e-Tax. **It's easy to apply!**In order to prevent identity theft, the applicant should come pick up the card themselves.

(1) Apply

Fill out the application that came with your My Number notification card, attach a picture, and post it in the mail.


② After about 1 month, receive a postcard in the mail.

Once the card is ready, you will receive a postcard from City Hall in the mail. Please call the number on the postcard to make an appointment to pick up your card.

Why Not Use Generic Medicine?

Generic medicine is made by a different company when the original brand's patent expires. Even though the name is different, generic medications have the same active ingredients, the same effect, and is also approved by the Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare. The only difference is that it is cheaper.

If you are worried about the effects of switching to generic medicine, you can do a trial period by consulting with your doctor or pharmacist.

To receive generic medication, please use the "Kibo Shiru" sticker or present the "Onegai Card" at the pharmacy counter. (Both the sticker and the card came inside the envelope when you received your health insurance card).
