



Applications for the 2022 Temporary Special Benefit for Households Raising Children in Koka City are Now Being Accepted (臨時特別給付金の申請)

If you are eligible for benefits, please apply by the deadline.

- Eligible Persons Parents or guardians raising a child or children aged 0-18 (born between April 2, 2004 and March 31, 2023)
 - *Only children whose address is registered in the city as of April 30, 2022 are eligible for the subsidy.
 - *There is no income limit.

Benefit Amount 10,000 yen per eligible child

Application forms have already been mailed to each child of eligible age.

For those not required to apply*:

The payment was deposited on July 25

Please Consider Vaccination Against Covid-19

Many cases of infection have been confirmed daily in Koka City. To prevent the spread of infection, please continue to take basic preventive measures. If you have not yet been vaccinated, please consider getting vaccinated to protect not only yourself but also your family, friends, and other loved ones.

Obtaining Covid-19 Vaccination Certificates at Convenience Stores

Vaccination certificates can be obtained at Seven-Eleven stores that have multi-copy machines in Koka City.

What You Need

- My Number Card + 4-digit PIN (PIN that you set when receiving your My Number Card)
- · Vaccination certificate issuance fee: 120 yen per certificate

Available Hours 6:30-23:00 (also available on weekends and national holidays)

Please Note

- Refunds will not be made after issuance, except for printing defects.
- In order to obtain an overseas vaccination certificate at Seven-Eleven stores, you must have registered your passport number at the city office or online (via the COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate app.) on or after July 21, 2022.

*If you are unable to apply at a child care facility for unavoidable reasons or if you need an interpreter, please come to a Chiiki Shimin Center or the Hoiku Yochien Ka.

- *8:30-17:15 for Chiiki Shimin Centers and the Hoiku Yochien Ka

*If you are unable to apply during the above hours, applications will be accepted at the Hoiku Yochien Ka on the following dates only:

- *Both current students and students with an informal offer for April 2023 enrollment are also required to submit an application.
- *Children who have already applied in the current school year and are on a waiting list need to apply again.
- *If you wish to enroll your child in the middle of the school year due to childcare leave or other reasons, please apply during this period. You may also apply for admission to a child care facility before the birth of your baby.

*All documents must be submitted by October 14 (Fri) in order to apply for admission for the 2023 school year. Documents submitted on or after October 15 will not be included in the admission screening process.
