Collection of Household Garbage

Due to the extremely high volume of garbage during the year-end and new-year period, normal collection times and routes may be significantly changed. Please be sure to put out your garbage at the collection point by 8:00 a.m. Also, please be sure to check the garbage calendar as the collection items and collection days may differ from the usual schedule. (Garbage calendars are available at City Hall and each Chiiki Shimin center, as well as on the city website.)

Household Waste Collection Facilities (Eco-Stations and the Koka Large Area Administrative Union Sanitation Center (Koka Koiki Gyosei Kumiai Eisei Center))

November Tax Payments

The due date for tax payments this month is <u>January 4 (Wed)</u>

- Fixed assets tax (3rd term installment)
- National health insurance tax (7th term installment)
- User fees (Nursery school, kindergarten fees and nursery school lunch fees)
- Long-term care insurance premium (7th term installment)
- · Medical insurance premiums for the elderly
- Water rates

It is convenient to use account-to-account transfers for payments.

On Tuesdays, the Shimin Ka in City Hall is open until 19:00 for issuing certificates such as family registers, residence certificates, tax certificates and for registering personal seals. *Please note that we cannot handle procedures related to the My Number Card or resident transfers (moving in, moving out, etc.).

Get Your Year-end Fire Prevention Plan in Place!

As the weather becomes colder, fires are more likely to occur due to the increased use of heating devices such as kerosene heaters and electric heaters. In addition, the busy end of year period means that fire safety becomes an afterthought. To prevent fires, follow these "4 Habits and 6 Measures!"

4 Habits

- 1. Don't smoke (or let your loved ones smoke) in bed.
- 2. Keep flammable items away from heaters.
- 3. When using a cooking stove, never leave it unattended.
- 4. Dust around electrical outlets and unplug appliances that aren't being used.

6 Measures

- 1. Use heaters, cooking stoves, and other appliances equipped with safety features.
- 2. Check residential fire alarms regularly and replace them every 10 years or so.
- 3. Keep rooms tidy and use fire-retardant bedding, clothing, and curtains.
- 4. Install fire extinguishers and learn how to use them.
- 5. The elderly and people with physical disabilities should be prepared to evacuate by knowing the safest routes and methods.
- 6. Take community-wide fire prevention measures by participating in fire drills and accepting door-to-door visits.

Have You Registered for Direct Debit Payments?

Koka City encourages you to use direct debit (automatic bank transfer) for payments of municipal taxes and user fees.

Convenient No need to go to city hall or a financial institution each time a payment is due. Once you complete the paperwork for direct debit, payments for the following year and thereafter will be made automatically.

Safe No need to carry cash.

Reliable No need to remember payment dates, and you can check your payment history from the entries in your bankbook.

How to Register

- Fill out the account transfer application form and stamp the seal registered on your bankbook.
- Submit the form directly to the counter of the financial institution where you wish to make the transfer.
- *Application forms are available at all financial institutions in the city. Generally, the transfer will start from the following month.

Tax Non-Payment Prevention Month Have You Paid All Your Taxes?

To ensure fair distribution of the tax burden, Koka City and Shiga Prefecture will reinforce non-payment prevention measures in December.

If payment is not made by the due date, deposits, savings, wages, etc. may be seized and your home or other properties may be searched.

If you are unable to pay your taxes due to unavoidable circumstances, please contact us as soon as possible.

Non-Payment Collection Procedure

Demand for Payment

A demand letter will be sent out if payment is not made within 20 days after the due date.

Property Investigation and Search Investigations are conducted at financial institutions, workplaces, and houses.

Seizure of Assets

Wages, deposits, real estate, automobiles, movable property, etc. are seized.

Sale and Transfer of Assets

The seized property will be collected and sold at public auction and converted into cash. The proceeds from the sale will be used to pay the overdue taxes.
