Wear a helmet to protect yourself

Follow the Five Rules for Safe Bicycle Use to ride safely!

Starting on April 1, 2023, anyone riding a bicycle is required to make their best effort to wear a helmet.

Within the bicycle accidents resulting in injury or death occurring in Shiga Prefecture in recent years, out of those accidents involving an elderly person not wearing a helmet, approximately 1 in 20 resulted in death.

Wear a helmet to protect your precious life! There was an increase in bicycle accidents in fiscal 2022 compared to the previous year.

To eliminate bicycle traffic accidents, let's all follow the Five Rules for Safe Bicycle Use to prevent them from occurring!

In addition, enrollment in a bicycle liability insurance plan is now required under the Ordinance Related to Safe and Proper Use of Bicycles in Shiga Prefecture.

Enroll in an insurance plan and ride your bike safely.

Five Rules for Safe Bicycle Use

- **1.** Generally ride on the left side of the road, and when riding on sidewalks yield to pedestrians.
- **2.** Follow the traffic signals at intersections, come to a complete stop, and confirm safety.
- 3. Turn on headlights at night.
- **4.** Do not ride under the influence.
- 5. Wear a helmet.

Important Information

- Applications are also required for children who are currently enrolled for the current school year (unofficially).
- Those who applied this year and have a child on the waiting list will also need to apply again for the 2024 school year.
- Those who want to enroll their children mid-year also need to apply during this application period.
- Applications are also accepted from expecting parents of currently unborn children.
- Some of the attachment forms for these applications are time-consuming, so please confirm the contents of the admission booklet and complete your application early.

Public Certified Childcare Centers (Part-time, No. 1 Certification)

From April 2024, Tsuchiyama, Ohara, Aburahi, and Shigaraki Kindergartens will be renamed Certified Childcare Centers.

What is a Certified Childcare Center?

A facility where kindergarten students (Part-time, No. 1 Certification) and nursery school students (Full-time, No. 2 and No. 3 Certification) can receive education and childcare together in the same classroom.

Application Period: September 4 (Mon) to 6 (Wed)

• Where to Apply: At the Certified Childcare Center where you wish to enroll

(During the application period, the facility is a kindergarten.)

Application Desk Hours: 8:30 am to 5:15 pm

*The necessary documents are available along with admission booklets at the Certified Childcare

Center where you wish to enroll, Nursery School and Kindergarten (Hoiku Yochien Ka), Community Civic (Chiiki Shimin) Centers in Tsuchiyama, Koka, Konan and Shigaraki, and various Parenting Support (Ko Sodate Shien) Centers.

*If you are unable to apply during the application period, you can apply at Nursery School and Kindergarten (Hoiku Yochien Ka) on September 7 (Thu) or 8 (Fri).

Important Information

- Application forms for children already enrolled in kindergarten this year will be distributed at each facility.
- Enrollment will be chosen by lottery system if there are many applicants.

(If a lottery is performed, selected applicants will be notified.)

• For information on private preschools, please contact each preschool.

You cannot apply to both public Certified Childcare Center (Part-time, No. 1 Certification) and another facility such as a nursery school.

Start of Applications for After-school Children's Clubs

Koka City has established "After-school Children's Clubs" to promote the healthy growth and development of children whose parents are unable to care for them at home during the day due to reasons such as work.

Those wishing to enroll their children in the school year starting in April 2024 are requested to apply during the period

*Children who meet the criteria and have a high level of need for after-school care will be given priority.

- Usage Time Weekdays: After school to 6:30 pm

- Base Fees ¥10,000/month for weekdays (Saturday and holiday usage will cost extra.)

Vaccination Eligibility All individuals who completed the initial vaccination are eligible.


* For ages 5 years and older, those who completed two vaccinations, and for ages 6 months to 4 years, those who completed three vaccinations.
