Severe rainstorm hit Koka City -Typhoon 18, September 15 & 16, 2013-Emergency warning was issued first time after it was launched August 30, 2013.



Severe rainstorm by Typhoon 18, hit Koka City from September 15 to 16. Total amount of this rainfall was 523mm (Tsuchiyama-cho, Okawara.) Considering Koka City's average total amount of rainfall per year is approximately 1700mm, it was 1/3 of it. Japan Meteorological Agency issued Emergency Warning for its first time after it was launched August 30, 2013. Koka City advised residents in some area to evacuate, and used loud speaker and voice broadcast terminal to alert people for evacuation. There was no human suffering in Koka City caused by this typhoon, but it left many damages. There are many lnundations above/below floor level, and mud slides. Especially in Shigaraki, over 70 houses had inundation above floor level and over 130 houses had inundations below floor level (as of 9/20.) Many roads are closed and SKR (Shigaraki Kogen Railway) lost 32m of bridge over the Soma River. Currently,

City employee will visit your house and check the damage. **Other:** ① It will take about a week for issuing this certificate. *It varies depend on the application status. ②This certificate is only issued for buildings (includes houses.) ③Certificate can be issued damages greater than partial damage of buildings (inundation included.)
