Subsidy Eligible Construction

Common Information

Construction work that falls under all of the following 1 to 3

- 1 Remodeling work ordered from a contractor (including subcontractors) headquartered in the city
- 2 Construction work that can be started and completed between April 1, 2023 and March 31, 2024
- 3 Cost for the construction work to be subsidized is ¥100,000 or more
- *Construction work for other purposes are not eligible. (Except for remodeling to promote carbon neutrality)
- *External construction work, construction work by contractors outside the city, etc. are not eligible for subsidy. Please check the Koka City website for details.

COVID-19 Vaccination for Spring 2023 Begins

2023 Spring Vaccination for COVID-19 will begin on May 8 (Mon). Group and individual vaccination will be offered this year as well. For details, please refer to the information enclosed with your vaccination coupon.

Vaccination Eligibility

Following persons who have received the first vaccination (1st and 2nd dose) and 3 months after the previous dose

- 1) Elderly (65 years old or older)
- ② Persons with underlying medical conditions or persons who are deemed by a physician to be at high risk of severe illness (5 to 64 years old)
- ③ Medical staff, etc. and staff at facilities that deal with elderly people

COVID-19 vaccine available

Omicron strain compatible bivalent vaccine, etc.

Vaccination coupons will be sent out sequentially after May 10 (Wed). However, those who fall under ② or ③ among those eligible for vaccination need to apply in advance for the issuance of vaccination coupons.

COVID-19 Category 5 Transition

On May 8 (Mon), COVID-19 will be treated as Category 5 under the Infectious Disease Control Law. The main changes are as follows.

The deadline for applying for My Number Points (up to ¥20,000) is the end of September



By linking a cashless payment service to a Individual Number Card issued on or before March 1, 2023 (applying for My Number Points), you can receive a maximum of ¥20,000 worth of My Number Points. The deadline for application is the end of September, so please apply as soon as possible.

Procedures using smartphones and PCs

Enter the 4-digit password (for user verification) in the My Number Points app, and apply after the card is scanned.

Information on Health Screening Fee Subsidy for FY2023

Koka City subsidizes the health screening fee for residents aged 40 years and older, and who have National Health Insurance (NHI). Eligible Persons for Subsidy People who meet all of the following conditions:

- Koka City residents aged between 40 and 74 years, and who have National Health Insurance (NHI) (residents who turn 75 this fiscal year will still be eligible if they are aged 74 years on their health screening day)
- 2 Households who are not behind in payments of National Health Insurance taxes.
- 3 People who receive a health screening that includes all of the special medical checkup items in the fiscal year ending by March 31, 2024.
- 4 People who would not receive a special medical checkup in the same fiscal year.

Subsidy Amount Half of the health screening fee (Up to ¥20,000. Up to ¥30,000 for people who receive a health screening that includes a brain checkup.) *The subsidy is only available once per fiscal year.
