Response to

Category 5 Transition

As of May 8 (Mon.), COVID-19 is treated as Category 5 under the Infectious Disease Control Law. As a result, the response to infection has changed as follows:

Voluntary restraint and recuperation period

- Voluntary restraint from going outside according to the Infectious Disease Control Law is no longer in effect, and leaving the home is now up to the individual's decision.
- The recuperation period for COVID-19 patients is 5 days after the date of onset (day 0) and 24 hours after the symptoms have subsided. Voluntary restraint is recommended during this period.

O Close contacts

Close contacts of COVID-19 patients are no longer identified or required by law to refrain from leaving the house.

Vaccination Without Appointment

Vaccinations are available without an appointment at the Seiyu Minakuchi Store, a site for group vaccinations that started in spring 2023. Please use this facility if scheduling appointments in advance is difficult or if your schedule has changed unexpectedly.

- * Priority will be given to those who have made advance reservations, and vaccinations may be unavailable due to a lack of supply.
- * A pre-examination ticket with vaccination coupon and applicant's identification document are required for vaccination.

Update By Post No Later Than July 4: Welfare Medical Expense Receipt Ticket, etc.

In order to reduce the financial burden of disabled and single-parent families, Koka City subsidizes their medical expenses.

Application period

Late June (as soon as you receive the renewal notice) to July 4 (Tue.)

Eligible persons

Those who currently have welfare medical expense receipt tickets, whose validity period ends on July 31, etc.

* Eligible persons will receive information in the mail, so please complete the update procedure by post.

How to apply

Application is to be made by post using the return envelope enclosed with the renewal notice

Koka City Scholarship Benefits Program

Koka City provides scholarships for those who have difficulty entering high school or university due to economic circumstances.

If your household's annual household income has changed suddenly due to unemployment, etc., your income status may now make you eligible, so please inquire.

Eligible persons The scholarship program is open to people who fulfill all of the following conditions:

- The student is receiving a Shiga Prefecture student loan, a JASSO scholarship, or another loan that is equivalent to these.
- 2 The student's parent/guardian has been living within Koka City continuously for one year or more prior to coming to receive the student loan per ① above.
- The student belongs to a household receiving Public Assistance based on the Public Assistance Act.

Benefit amount Senior high school or school for special needs education (senior high school course), etc.: 5,000 yen / month College, university, etc. (excluding graduate school): 15,000 yen / month

Application period June 12 (Mon.) to July 31 (Mon.)

* Those who were eligible in the previous year need to apply again each year.

1 Use it as an ID card

The Individual Number Card can be used when ID is required for the use of public facilities or various applications.

Get various certificates at convenience stores

Get copies of your resident register, taxation certificates, etc. at convenience stores, without going to the City Hall.

6 Easy tax-related procedures

Tax returns and payments can be filed online, making tax-related procedures easy.

Use it as a health insurance card

The Individual Number Card also functions as a health insurance card. Therefore, you will no longer need to carry your health insurance card.

How do I use my Individual Number Card as a health insurance card?

* You need to make an application. You can apply by installing the Mynaportal (My Number Portal) App on the smartphone which can scan your Individual Number Card. You can also apply through the facial recognition card readers at Seven Bank ATMs, medical institutions, and pharmacies.

<Benefits>

- Use your Individual Number Card as a health insurance card even if you are in the process of getting hired, getting a new job, or relocating.
- You can complete your tax returns online because your medical expense information can be managed on the Mynaportal (My Number Portal).
