



## English Examination Fee Subsidies Are Available for Junior High School Students Living in The City

In order to increase students' interest in English and motivate them to study English on their own, the city subsidizes the fees for English examinations for junior high school students.

**Eligible Persons** Parents of junior high school students living in the city.

\*Even if your child is not attending a municipal school in Koka, you can apply for the subsidy.

**How to Apply** [Koka Municipal School students]

Applications for subsidies will be handled by the school.

The subsidy will be provided only for examinations taken at the school.

[Non-Koka Municipal School students]

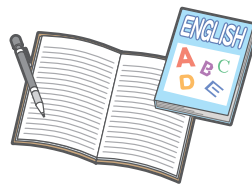
Please apply directly to the School Education Section of City Hall.

**Application Deadline** Within 30 days from the date of the first test of the English Language Proficiency Test.

\*Applications for the test must be made on an individual basis.

## Support for Students Entering High School or University Koka City Scholarship System

Koka City Scholarships are provided to those who have difficulty attending high school or university for financial reasons.

Households that have experienced a sudden change in household finances due to reasons such as job loss may also be eligible, depending on their most recent income status.

**Eligible Persons** Those who meet all of the following criteria ①, ② and ③.

- ① Those who are receiving a Shiga Prefecture Scholarship Loan, a Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) Scholarship Loan, or a scholarship loan equivalent to these.
- ② Those whose guardians have lived in the city for at least one year prior to the date of receipt of the scholarship loan mentioned in ① above.
- ③ Those who belong to a household receiving public assistance under the Public Assistance Act or its equivalent.

**Amount** High schools and the high school division of special support schools..... ¥5,000 per month  
 University and college (excluding graduate schools) ..... ¥15,000 per month

**Application Period** June 10 (Mon) - July 31 (Wed)

\*Applications must be made every year. Please reapply if you received the scholarship in the previous year.

# Hearing Aid Purchase Subsidy Program for Seniors!



In order to improve quality of life and encourage social participation through the use of hearing aids, the program subsidizes a portion of the purchase cost of hearing aids.

## Eligible Persons

Persons 65 years of age or older from resident tax-exempt households who have been recognized by a physician to be in need of hearing aids.

(Except in cases where the hearing aid purchase cost is subsidized by other programs.)

## Subsidy Amount

One half of the cost of the hearing aid unit or ¥20,000, whichever is lower.

\*Applications will close when the budgeted amount of ¥1.4 million has been reached.

# Complete the Renewal Paperwork for the "Welfare Medical Expense Certificate" by July 3 by mail

The city provides medical expense subsidies to reduce the financial burden on people with disabilities and single-parent families.

Renewal information will be sent to those who are eligible, so please complete the paperwork and return it by mail.

## Application Period

From the date the renewal notice is received (late June) until July 3 (Wed)

## Eligible Persons

Holders of welfare medical expense benefit certificates (福祉医療費受給券 Fukushi Iryohi Jukyukken) with an expiration date of July 31, 2024.

\*Please consult with us about eligibility requirements if you wish to make a new application.

# Expanding Eligibility for Health Checkups for the Older Elderly for Early Detection of Illness and Monitoring of Health Conditions

The city has been conducting health examinations for persons insured by the Elderly Medical Care Insurance System. Until now, these health checkups have been limited to a certain group of people, but in order to encourage a wider range of insured persons to take the checkups, eligibility will be expanded. For early detection of illnesses that have no obvious symptoms, as well as for monitoring your own health condition and improving your health, please take the medical checkup.

## Eligible Persons

**Those who are enrolled in the Elderly Medical Care Insurance System**

\*Persons residing in a nursing home or hospitalized for a long period of time (more than 6 months) are not eligible.

## Details of Health Checkups

Medical interview, physical measurements, blood pressure measurement, blood tests (blood lipids, liver function, blood sugar, kidney function), urinalysis

## How to Take the Health Checkup

- ① The city will send a health checkup ticket (lemon color) by mail in early June 2024 to those who are eligible for the checkup.
- ② Please select a medical institution from the enclosed "List of Medical Institutions(医療機関一覧表)" and take a health checkup. There is no charge for this service.

\*Some medical facilities require reservations.

# The Long-term Care Insurance Premiums Rate for Fiscal Years 2024 - 2026 have been determined

Based on the Long-Term Care Insurance Law, the Long-Term Care Insurance Business Plan has been revised in fiscal 2024. The long-term care insurance rates for the next three years have been determined based on the projected cost of long-term care service benefits and the number of persons certified as requiring long-term care.

**Average amount of insurance premiums for the fiscal years 2024 to 2026**

..... ¥71,280 per year (¥5,940 per month)

There are 14 levels of yearly premiums based on this average amount to ensure that payments are proportionate to income.

Insured persons will receive a premium determination notice in June.

# Subsidies for Newly Married Life in Koka City!



For couples starting their married life in Koka City, The city will subsidize a part of the housing and moving expenses for couples starting their married life in Koka City.

## Amount of Subsidy

Up to ¥300,000 (housing and moving expenses associated with the marriage)

## Eligible Households

- Households whose marriage registration was accepted between January 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025.
- As of the date of marriage, both spouses are under 39 years old and have a resident registration at the place they moved into.
- Households whose place of residence is in Koka City.
- The total income of both spouses must be less than ¥5,000,000 and some other conditions.
