To assist with increased demand due to a seasonal rise in job transfers, new employment, and school enrollment, we will temporarily open city hall on the following Sundays to allow citizens to complete procedures for change of address.

When March 29 (Sat) and April 6 (Sun), 8:30 – 12:00 (noon)

- Services Address changes (moving in, moving out, and change of address)
 - Seal Registration, Seal Certification
 - Issuance of documents (residence certificates, family registers, tax certificates, income certificates)
 - Issuance of school admission/transfer notices

Note: Please note that some procedures and certificates can only be provided on weekdays.



You Can Complete Moving Out Procedures Online **Using Your My Number Card!**

If you have a My Number card, you can submit your moving-out notification online via the Mynaportal website. However, you will still need to complete the necessary procedures in person at the city hall of the city (town or village) you are moving to within 14 days of moving into your new address.

From 30 days before, and until 10 days after moving to the new address.

Rabies Group Vaccination Schedule for 2025

令和7年度狂犬病予防集合注射を実施します

Dogs aged 91 days or older must be registered (once) and vaccinated against rabies (once a year). Please have your dogs vaccinated via group vaccination or at a veterinary clinic. Koka City entrusts the Shiga Veterinary Medical Association to issue rabies vaccination certificates and dog tags.

Contact Seikatsu Kankyo-Ka for any changes to registration information, including change of address or if your dog passes away.

What to Bring

For Registered Dogs

- Dog registration card (Aiken Card 愛犬 カード)
- "Notice of Rabies Vaccination (狂犬病予防注 射のお知らせ)" postcard, sent in late March.
- Vaccination fee (¥3,500)

- Please complete the medical questionnaire attached to the postcard in advance to ensure the smooth delivery of vaccinations.
- Consult with a veterinarian prior to vaccination if your dog is pregnant, has just given birth, or is in poor physical condition.

For Unregistered Dogs

- Dog registration fee (¥3,000)
- Vaccination fee (¥3,500)

Pet Ownership Etiquette

Pets like dogs and cats are important to humans, but their care requires responsibility and manners. Issues such as noise and not cleaning up after pets in public places can cause inconvenience to others and lead to trouble

Let's review the etiquette of pet ownership.

Dog Care

When Walking your Dog

When walking your dog, be sure to use a leash and prepare items such as a shovel, plastic bag, and water to clean up dog feces and urine.

• Make Sure to Clean Up Dog Feces

Dog feces left on the streets and in other public areas causes trouble to local residents. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dog.



Cat Care

Keep Cats Indoors

There are many dangers to cats outside, such as accidents and disease transmission. In addition, cat feces and urine can cause problems for other community members.

Spaying and Neutering

Have cats spayed or neutered to avoid having more kittens that you can care for.

Preventing the Increase of Stray Cats

Are you feeding stray cats without thinking? Feces, meowing, and damage to fields and other areas can cause trouble in the community. If you feed stray cats, keep them indoors as part of the family.

2025 Applications for Reduction/ **Exemption of Light Motor Vehicle Tax** (by Vehicle Type) Starts from April

4月から令和7年度軽自動車税(種別割)の減免申請の受付が始まります

If any of the following conditions are met, the Light Motor Vehicle Tax (by vehicle type) can be reduced or exempted by submitting an application during the time period below.



Conditions of Eligibility

- Light motor vehicles that meet the requirements and are used by persons with a Physical Disability Certificate, a Mental Disability Certificate, a Rehabilitation Certificate, or a War Injury and Sickness Certificate.
- Light motor vehicles used by public institutions or local community organizations for their public service projects.
- Light motor vehicles whose structure has been approved by the government as being suitable for people with disabilities, etc.

Note: Determination of eligibility for reduction/exemption depends on the conditions of ownership of the light motor vehicle, the disability category, and the grade of the disability certificate.

Application Period

In-Person Applications

From April 1 (Tue) to May 26 (Mon)*

Eligible Persons First-time applicants or those with changes to last year's application details.

Where to Apply Zeimu Ka, each Chiiki Shimin Center

Postal Applications

From April 1 (Tue) to 15 (Tue)**

Eligible Persons For those with no changes to last year's application details.

- *You cannot apply after the in-person application period.
- **You can apply in person until May 26, after the postal application period has ended.

Change the Ownership of Your Light Vehicle or Submit a Scrap Report for the Vehicle as Necessary

The Light Motor Vehicle Tax (by vehicle type) must be paid by owners of motorized bicycles, light three and four-wheeled vehicles, and small special vehicles (agricultural vehicles, forklifts) on April 1 every year. Note that if you change the ownership or scrap a car after April 2, the tax (by vehicle type) will be still charged.

If the owner of the vehicle has changed (passed away) and the vehicle is no longer being driven, please change the name of the owner or scrap the vehicle by April 1.

Tax Declaration (for Tax Suspension) When Changing **Registered Name or Address Outside Shiga Prefecture**

If you change the registration of a light motor vehicle or motorcycle (with engine displacement over 125cc) outside of Shiga Prefecture, such as changing the ownership, changing the address, or scrapping the vehicle, you must file a "tax declaration (税止め zei-dome)" to stop taxation in Koka City.

If you forget to file the report, the city will not be able to track the vehicle's registration status, and the Light Motor Vehicle Tax (by vehicle type) will continue to be charged.

Please don't forget to file a declaration for tax suspension in the case of ownership change (transfer of registration), otherwise the tax notice will be sent to the former owner, which may cause unexpected problems.

Don't Forget to Apply for Child Allowance!

児童手当の申請をお忘れなく

The child allowance system changed in October 2024. If you have not yet applied, please do so by the deadline.

- Eligible Persons Those who are not raising any children of junior high school age or younger, and are only raising children of high school age
 - Those who were not eligible for the special benefit payment due to exceeding the income limit before the revision
 - Those who are receiving the Child Allowance/Special Benefit Payment and are raising three or more children, including those up to the end of the fiscal year in which they turn 22.

Application Deadline

March 31 (Mon)*

*If the deadline is missed, you will not receive benefits for the month before the application month.

- Applications 1 In-person applications: Kosodate Seisaku Ka at City Hall or each Chiiki Shimin Center (8:30-17:15 on weekdays)
 - ②Online applications: Koka City website (My Number Card and NFC compatible smart phone required)
