



### ②Subsidy for Carbon Neutral Promotion Renovation (Budget: ¥6,000,000).

This subsidy is for those who carry out renovation work on their homes by installing environmentally-specific products that support a decarbonized society.

Subsidy Eligibility Requirements	Subsidy Amount
Installation of solar power generation systems, stationary storage batteries, high-efficiency water heaters, solar heat utilization systems and window insulation systems in the residence. *Carbon neutral promotion renovation subsidies are also available to those who have received home renovation subsidies in the past. However, those who have received carbon neutral promotion renovation subsidies in the past are not eligible.  *It is not possible to apply for this project in conjunction with the Subsidy for House Renovation to Support Households Raising Children and Promote Settlement.	20% of the subsidized construction costs Up to ¥100,000

#### ≪Requirements For Additional Subsidy≫

### Additional Subsidy for New Residents

#### Additional Subsidy for Biwa Timber Users

- ¥100,000 will be added to the maximum amount.
- \*Biwako timber is timber produced in Shiga Prefecture.
- \*Biwako timber must be purchased from a local business registered as a certified Biwako timber-handling business.
- \*When Biwako Timber is used as finishing material for floors, walls, etc. over 10m or as structural timber over 1m .

#### ≪Renovation Work Eligible for Subsidy≫

Works corresponding to all of the following 1 to 3

- DRenovation work ordered to a contractor (including subcontractors) whose head office is in Koka City.
- Construction work that can be started and completed between 1 April 2024 and 31 March 2025.
- 3 Works that meet the requirements for subsidy and cost 100,000 yen or more.

\*Works covered by another subsidy are not eligible.

\*Exterior works and works carried out by contractors outside the city may not be eligible for assistance.

Application Deadline May 31 (Fri) \*Applications by post must arrive by this date \*If the budgeted amount for each subsidy category is exceeded, an open lottery will be held for general households only.


### Reservations for large burnable waste will be continued to reinforce correct disposal

# Issuance of Subsidy Vouchers for **Maternity Health Checkups**

#### Eligible Persons

Those who gave birth on or after 1 April 2024 and who will subsequently undergo a maternal health checkup.

\*Those who have moved out of Koka on the day of the checkup are not eligible.

#### Amount of Subsidy Vouchers

Two vouchers for up to ¥5,000 per health checkup.

### Contents of Subsidy

Expenses for antenatal checkups carried out at medical institutions in the immediate postpartum period (at 2 weeks postpartum and at 1 month postpartum).

- General health assessment
- Weight and blood pressure
- Urinalvsis
- Mental health check

### How to Obtain the Voucher

At the time of issuance of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook at health centers.

\*Subsidy coupons have been sent to those who have received their Maternal and Child Health Handbook by 31 March 2024 and are due to give birth on or after 1 April 2024.

The post-natal period is a time of great physical and mental strain due to childcare in addition to postpartum fatigue. Make sure you visit a doctor to check your overall health.







### For People Aged 40-74 Years with National Health Insurance

# **Notice of Subsidies for Comprehensive** Health Checkup System (Ningen Dock)

#### Eligible persons

Those who meet all of the following criteria

- ①People aged between 40 and 74 who are covered by the National Health Insurance (applicable if they are 74 years old on the date of the examination).
- ②Households that are not behind in paying National Health Insurance tax.
- 3 Those who will undergo a Ningen Dock that includes all the tests covered in the Lifestyle Health Checkup by 31 March 2025.
- (4) Those who will not take the Lifestyle Health Checkup within the same fiscal year (only one of Ningen Dock or Lifestyle Health Checkup can be taken within the same fiscal year).

#### Amount of the Subsidy

- 1/2 of the medical checkup costs
- \*Up to ¥20,000. However, if the checkup includes a brain scan, the upper limit is ¥30,000.
- \*The subsidy can only be provided once per fiscal year.

#### How to Apply

- 1 [Pre-application] Bring your Koka City Lifestyle Health Checkup ticket (collected by staff) and your National Health Insurance card.
- 2 [Application for reimbursement] Bring your National Health Insurance card, medical check-up results, payment receipts and evidence of your bank account for subsidy payment.
  - \*Medical checkup results and payment receipts will be photocopied.

# **2024 National Health Insurance Tax Amount** Will Change

#### 1) Revised tax rates and other changes

The National Health Insurance tax rates for FY2024 will be revised to compensate for the shortfall in revenue in the National Health Insurance Special Account budget due to a decrease in the number of insured persons and an increase in medical expenses.

### 2 Progress of the revision

According to the policies of the national government and Shiga Prefecture, a standard insurance tax rate has been proposed with the aim of achieving a unified insurance tax rate for the prefecture in 2027 to equalize the burden on subscribers. We ask for your understanding, including the fact that tax rates will need to be revised in stages in the future to achieve prefectural unification.
