# **How Will Things Change? Vol.2 Using Your My Number Card** as a Health Insurance Card



マイナンバーカードの保険証利用

From December 2, 2024, paper health insurance cards will no longer be issued. Instead, a new system called 'Myna Hokensho' will be introduced.

You can use your health insurance card until the expiration date indicated on your health insurance card.

### Frequently Asked Questions About Myna Hokensho

- Q: After December 2, will I receive a health insurance card if I newly enroll in the National Health **Insurance or the Elderly Medical Care Insurance?**
- A: Health insurance cards will not be issued, but those who have registered for Myna Hokensho\* will receive a "Shikaku Joho no Oshirase (Notice of Eligibility Information)" with their details. All other people will receive a "Shikaku Kakuninsho (Certificate of Eligibility)" instead of a health insurance card.
  - Please note that for people with Elderly Medical Care Insurance, a "Shikaku Kakuninsho (Certificate of Eligibility)" will be issued until July 31, 2025, even if they are registered for Myna Hokensho\*.
- \* Myna Hokensho is the new format for health insurance cards. It combines your health insurance information with your My Number Card.

- Q: What should I do if I am registered for Myna Hokensho. but have difficulty using it because I am in a nursing home for the elderly?
- A: For those who need special consideration, such as elderly people requiring nursing care and people with disabilities, a "Shikaku Kakuninsho (Certificate of Eligibility)" can be issued to replace health insurance cards upon application. For details, please inquire with your insurer.

### 1 Have a "Kakaritsukei (Primary Care Physician)"!

A "Kakaritsukei" is a primary care physician you and your family can consult for various illnesses and health issues. Having a Kakaritsukei offers many benefits, such as daily health management, early illness detection, and referrals to specialized medical institutions.

# 2 Be Informed on How to Receive Medical Care on Holidays and at Night in Case of Injury or Sudden

"Should I go see a doctor now, even though it's the middle of the night?" "I need to go to a medical institution, but the nearest clinic is closed on holidays..."

Have you ever faced a situation like this? It is important to know in advance how and where to consult a doctor in case of sudden illness or injury.

### **3 Get Regular Checkups and Examinations!**

It's important to monitor your health and understand your body through regular medical checkups. Even if you have no symptoms, routine health checkups and cancer screenings can lead to early detection and treatment.

Child abuse is a human rights violation that harms children's physical and mental health and greatly impacts their personality development.

### Types of Child Abuse

There are 4 types of child abuse: physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, and psychological abuse.

Be Aware of Signs That Children or Their Parents/ **Guardians Show** 

### **Example of Signs Children Show**

- You often hear a child crying or his or her parent/ guardian yelling from the same house.
- Clothes and/or body are always dirty.

### **Example of Signs Parents/Guardians Show**

- She/he has less interaction with the community and is isolated.
- She/he goes out leaving children alone at home.

### **Contact Us Immediately When You Suspect Abuse**

You don't need to provide any proof of child abuse. The privacy of informants is strictly protected. Reports can also be made anonymously.

### The due date for tax payments this month is: December 2 (Mon)

- National health insurance tax (6th term installment)
- User fees (Nursery school, kindergarten fees and nursery school lunch fees)
- Long-term care insurance premium (6th term installment)
- Medical insurance premiums for the elderly
- Public sewage fees and agricultural community drainage facility fees

Direct debit is a convenient way to manage payments.

Autumn brings drier air and fires are more likely to occur across the country as people start using heating equipment and other fire related items. Please take this opportunity to think about fire and disaster prevention in your daily life!

### Check if Residential Fire Alarms Are Installed at the Right **Location in Your House!**

Residential fire alarms must be installed in bedrooms and above stairs (if bedrooms are on the second floor or higher). Inspect and clean them regularly to ensure that they work properly in an emergency. In addition, residential fire alarms should be replaced approximately 10 years after installation. Older alarms may no longer detect fires due to the limited lifespan of electronic components or running out of batteries. The installation and maintenance of residential fire alarms is very important to reduce the damage caused by house fires! For more information on residential fire alarms, please visit our website.
