• What is the "Childcare System for All Children"?

The "Childcare System for All Children (Kodomo Daredemo Tsuen Seido)" is a system that aims to support the nurturing of all children, allowing any child to attend a nursery school or other childcare facility regardless of their parents' employment status.

• What's the Difference Between This System and Temporary Childcare Services?

Temporary Childcare Services (Ichiji Azukari) provide short-term care at childcare facilities when parents need help due to work or other reasons. The Childcare System for All Children, on the other hand, lets children attend childcare regularly to support their growth and development no matter their parents' job situation.

Koka City plans to implement this system on a trial basis starting in fiscal year 2025. For details, including the start date and participating facilities, please check the city website.

Eligible Children

Children aged 6 months to under 3 years old who are registered residents of Koka City and do not attend nursery school or other childcare facilities.

Please Connect to the Sewerage System ASAP!

It is mandatory to convert pit toilets to flush toilets within 3 years of public sewerage installation in the area. Also, septic tanks must be connected to the public sewerage system without delay. Those who are in an area where public sewerage or agricultural community drainage can be used, but have not yet connected, are requested to do so as soon as possible.

City Designated Contractor for All Drainage System Work

Drainage system work must be done by a fully qualified contractor who has been approved by the city.

Financing and Interest Subsidy Program

Assistance in the form of special loans and interest subsidies is available to those who want to connect to the public sewerage system.(There are some conditions).

Oversized trash and general household waste is often dumped into agricultural irrigation canals. These items obstruct the flow of water and also cause clogging, causing water to overflow and inconvenience residents in the neighborhood. Also, when moving grass around waterways, please be careful not to let cut grass fall into the canals. Grass causes clogging of waterways, too.

The area near waterways can be extremely dangerous. The water may also rise quickly during typhoons or sudden heavy rainfall. Please stay away from the canals.
