

Supplementary Benefit Payment I

Payment Recipients

People whose "fixed tax reduction" plus the "FY2024 adjustment benefit" is less than the "maximum possible tax reduction amount."

Maximum possible tax reduction amount =

Income tax: 30,000 yen × (you + dependents) + Resident tax: 10,000 yen × (you + dependents)

Examples:

- Your income in 2024 is lower than in 2023 (due to retirement, leave from work, or childcare leave, for example).
- Your number of dependents increased in 2024 (due to the birth of a child or other reasons).

Payment Amount The shortfall between the received amount and the maximum eligible reduction.

Supplementary Benefit Payment II

Payment Recipients People who meet all three of the following conditions:

- ①Your income tax and resident tax for 2024 were both zero before the fixed tax reduction.
- 2You are not counted as a dependent for tax purposes (because you are a business-exclusive family worker or your total income is more than 480,000 yen).
- 3You are not the head of a household or a household member who received the special benefit for lowincome households.

Payment Amount 40,000 yen (fixed amount)*

*30,000 yen if you were living outside Japan on January 1, 2024

Eligible persons will receive one of the following by mail:

- A "Payment Notice"
- A "Confirmation Form"
- An "Application Form"

2 Identify Evacuation Sites

- Check evacuation routes to schools, community centers, and other designated evacuation sites.
- Talk with family members about where to go and how to stay in touch during a disaster.
- When evacuating, pack light. Use a backpack or bag that leaves both hands

3 Prepare Essential Items for Emergencies

Food (for at least 3 days)

Bottled water (3L per person per day), instant rice, ready-made pouch foods, dried bread, etc.

Daily necessities

Flashlight, mobile battery, portable radio, tissues, lighter, blankets, etc.

- Clothing Jackets, underwear, socks, etc.
- Valuables Cash, ID card, copy of bankbook, etc.

Toothbrush, towel, first-aid supplies, medications for chronic illnesses, regular medicines, medication record booklet etc.



4 Be Aware of Alert Levels and Evacuation Timing

Alert Level 5 (Emergency Safety Measures) indicates a life-threating situation in which you can no longer safely evacuate. Move upstairs and/or into the room furthest from any cliffs.

When Alert Level 4 (Evacuation Order) is issued, all residents in danger should evacuate immediately.

When Alert Level 3 (Evacuation of the Elderly and Others) is issued, elderly people, those with disabilities, and others who need more time to evacuate should begin evacuating.

Monthly Tax Payments 今月の納税

The due date for tax payments this month is: <u>September 30 (Tue)</u>

- National health insurance tax (4th term installment)
- User fees (Nursery school, kindergarten fees and nursery school lunch fees)
- Long-term care insurance premium (4th term installment)
- Medical insurance premiums for the elderly
- Public sewage fees and agricultural community drainage facility fees

Direct debit is a convenient way to manage payments.



Keep Your Septic Tank Well Maintained 浄化槽の適正な維持管理を

For household septic tanks, Japanese law requires three types of maintenance: regular inspection, cleaning, and official yearly inspection. Please make sure to do all these to keep your tank working properly.

Regular Inspection

Check and adjust the equipment, and refill the disinfectant at least three times a year.

Cleaning

Remove sludge and waste from inside the tank, and wash the equipment and parts at least **once a year**.

Official Yearly Inspection

Once a year, your septic tank must be officially inspected by Shiga Environmental Sanitation Union (Shiga Seikatsu Kankyo Jigyo Kyokai) to confirm that maintenance and cleaning have been done properly and that the septic tank is working properly.

If your tank isn't well maintained, the water coming out may become dirty and bad smells can occur, which can make your living environment unpleasant. If you live in an area without public sewer service and your household combined septic tank needs repair, you may be able to receive financial support from the city. Please check with the city office for details.
