



Proper Use of the Sewerage System

Please note the following points to ensure smooth operation of the sewerage system.

Restroom Use toilet paper Kitchen Put a strainer in the sink

Things that should not be put down the drain or toilet

- Cooking oil, vegetable scraps, leftover food
- Highly volatile and toxic liquids such as gasoline and thinners
- Solid materials such as cloth, vinyl and plastics
- Strongly acidic/alkaline chemicals and pesticides
- Large amounts of boiling water
- Dog, cat, and other animal feces and urine
- Disposable diapers, wet wipes

No Rainwater!

Allowing rainwater into the sewer pipes may lead to issues including sewage overflow. We request that each household conducts inspections and addresses any instances of rainwater inflow.
